ADVENTURE ACTIVITIES

HIGH ROPES COURSE

Duration: 2-3 hours
Cost: \$22.00 (wd) \$25.00 (we) per person

Fairbridge's high ropes course is made up of elements that start at 3.5m high and progressively get more difficult and higher (5m) around the course. Great for developing trust and confidence. (Recommended for ages 12+).

ROCK CLIMBING WALL

Duration: 1.5 hours
Cost 8m: \$14.50 (wd) \$17.50 (we) per person
Cost 15m: \$18.00 (wd) \$21.00 (we) per person

With the choice of either an 8m or 15m climb, participants undergo a challenging climb using a safety rope 'belay' device which is supervised by an experienced instructor – can be run in conjunction with abseiling.

ABSEILING TOWER

Duration: 2 hours
Cost 8m: \$22.00 (wd) \$25.00 (we) per person
Cost 15m: \$27.00 (wd) \$30.00 (we) per person

With the choice of an 8m or 15m wall there is a challenge here for all. Top role belay is used for safety. Abseiling can be run in conjunction with rock climbing.

GIANT SWING

Duration: 1.5 hours
Cost: \$14.50 (wd) \$17.50 (we) per person

Set on a 3m raised platform, our giant swing provides participants with an exhilarating rush as they fly through the air while safely secured by a harness – can be run in conjunction with the flying fox.

FLYING FOX

Duration: 1.5 hours
Cost: \$14.50 (wd) \$17.50 (we) per person

Our flying fox starts from a platform 3m from the ground and travels down a slight hill for 80m. Fantastic for all ages especially younger children – can be run in conjunction with the giant swing.

LOW ROPES & TEAM ADVENTURE GAMES

Duration: 1.5 hours
Cost: \$14.50 (wd) \$17.50 (we) per person

The low ropes course and adventure games are fantastic for those looking to develop a team or offer not only physical but mental challenge to your group. You will be given fun games and problem solving activities to stretch your team's initiative, teamwork & communication skills. Great for all ages.

RIVER CROSSING

Duration: 1.5 hours
Cost: \$14.50 (wd) \$17.50 (we) per person

A group activity aimed at establishing team building and problem solving skills. Groups are challenged to cross the South Dandalup River using rope and pulleys under supervision. Participants will require all their skill to ensure that the team crosses the river and stays dry.

AMAZING RACE

Duration: 1.5 -2 hours
Cost: \$14.50 (wd) \$17.50 (we) per person

A great team building activity in which participants compete in teams against each other in a race to complete challenging tasks set out before them.

ORIENTEERING/ SEARCH FOR NUMBERS

Duration: 1-1.5 hours
Cost: \$6.50 (wd) \$9.50 (we) per person OR
\$4.50 (wd) \$7.50 (we) self-facilitated

Orienteering gives the students an opportunity to learn to map read without using a compass (can be adapted for compass use). Search for Numbers is fantastic for students who are younger or in wheelchairs.

BIKE HIKE

Duration: 1.5 hour
Cost: \$14.50 (wd) \$17.50 (we) per person

A casual bike ride through the fascinating Fairbridge grounds and out to the old cemetery.

ARCHERY

Duration: 1.5 hours
Cost: \$14.50 (wd) \$17.50 (we) per person

An exciting activity where budding Archers are given the opportunity to learn some new skill or improve on existing ones. For groups of up to 20 at a time.

HAY RIDE

Duration: 1 hour
Cost: \$10.00 (wd) \$13.00 (we) per person

Travel on a purpose built trailer through Fairbridge Village and take a series of winding gravel tracks through the native bushland that surrounds. This can also include a visit to the Fairbridge Cemetery. (Maximum 20 people per session. Fantastic activity to be run at dusk or in the evening to view the kangaroos.)

CEMETERY HIKE

Duration: 2 hours
Cost: \$6.50 (wd) \$9.50 (we) per person

Enjoy a day or night hike to Fairbridge's Historical Cemetery. A fantastic way to see some of the local flora and fauna or view the night sky and the openness of the bush and immerse yourself in the history of Fairbridge.

POOL LIFEGUARD FOR SWIMMING

Cost: \$50 per hour (wd) \$55 per hour (we)

The activities staff are all qualified with their Bronze medalion and can come and watch the pool for you, so you can sit back and relax. Maximum 30 people in the pool at once.

POOL GAMES

Duration: 1.5 hours
Cost: \$10.00 (wd) \$13.00 (we) per person

Fully supervised and fun pool games and sports. Ideal for summer camps.

ECO HIKE

Duration: 1 hour
Cost: \$6.50 (wd) \$9.50 (we) per person

Enjoy a 2 kilometre hike along the banks of the mighty South Dandalup River learning about the regions history, river ecology and water management issues.

BUSH SURVIVAL

Duration: 1 hour
Cost: \$5.50 (wd) \$8.50 (we) per person

An activity designed to show the advantages of team work as participants work in groups to gather food, water, shelter and fire to aid the group survival.

BUSH DAMPER

Duration: 1 hour
Cost: \$6.50 (wd) \$9.50 (we) per person

Participants travel back into the days of our early settlers to make a morning or afternoon tea with a difference. An excellent activity to combine with the Eco Hike (subject to fire restrictions).

VILLAGE TOUR

Duration: 1 hour
Cost: \$4.50 (wd) \$7.50 (we) per person

Start your camp off with a tour of the village to learn your way around. Tours will include the history of Fairbridge, as well as what we do today to keep the village running and the community involved. Can include a Fairbridge Museum visit.

RIVER WATCH

Duration: 1 hour
Cost: \$6.50 (wd) \$9.50 (we) per person

Participants are invited to explore the ecosystem of the South Dandalup River and conduct a river assessment. Participants will learn about river ecology and stream life as well as water quality and water management issues relating to the Peel region. This activity can be tailored to any age group and all weather conditions.

MINI GOLF

Duration: 1 hour
Cost: \$4.50 (wd) \$7.50 (we) per person OR
\$3.00 (wd) \$6.00 (we) self-facilitated

Come and take a stroll around our mini golf course. Nine challenging holes present the player with a mission to complete and to beat all the other competitors. Interpretative signage enables participants to learn about the plight of some of the region's endangered animals, ensuring participants increase both their skills and their environmental knowledge.

BOOMERANG MAKING

Duration: 1 hour
Cost: \$12.00 (wd) \$15 (we) per person
\$7.50 (wd) \$10.50 (we) self-facilitated

Sand and paint a design of your choice on your boomerang and then give it a test flight. This is a nice casual activity enjoyed by young and old, but particularly primary school-age children.

CANOE TOURS, EXPEDITIONS & CAMPOUTS

LOCAL CANOE TOURS

These tours offer participants a day of fun and indulgence. All tours are held on the local Murray River. Tours can include stops at Redcliffe on the Murray, Peel Zoo, Pinjarra Church, local reserves, picnic and barbecue spots.

SUN, SURF AND SAND EXPEDITION

Discover amazing marine life and beautiful beaches as Fairbridge's Outdoor Recreation instructors take you to local beaches to conduct surfing, snorkeling, island exploration, sand sculpture building, beach volleyball and cricket.

Cost: Prices vary depending on group size, length of tour/expedition and catering. Free quotes and customised itineraries can be made up to suit your needs.

MOUNTAIN BIKING & CANOEING

Held at various spots throughout Dwellingup's Lane Poole Reserve. A great mix of adventure, camping, activity, endurance and fun.

BIBBULMUN TRACK HIKE

Participants will be able to explore a section of the epic Bibbulmun Track. Hike during the day and campout under the stars at night.

SOUTH WEST EXPERIENCE

Your group is transported to WA's stunning South West coast where they will get the opportunity to go hiking, camping, caving, rock climbing, abseiling, canoeing and surfing.

CAMPOUT IN TENTS (Overnight)

For the rustic bush camping experience you can stay a night along the South Dandalup River. One of our instructors can spend the night with you and oversee all the cooking of dinner (done by the students), and entertainment for the night.

OFF-SITE ADVENTURE ACTIVITIES

NATURAL ABSEILING SITE

Duration: 2 hours
Costs: Vary (see below)

A fun filled morning or afternoon at our natural 12m abseiling site. There are different ways to arrive from walking, mountain biking or a bus journey. Then undertake a thrilling abseil down the granite face taking in the amazing views of the South Dandalup River. You can even try the challenge of the natural climb before heading back to Fairbridge.

Per person:

Natural Abseiling: \$27.50 (wd) \$30.50 (we)

Natural Abseiling + Climbing \$37.50 (wd) \$40.50 (we)

South Dandalup River walk to site \$11 each way per person

Bike to site \$13 each way per person

RAFT KIT BUILDING

Duration: 2 hours
Cost: \$22.00 (wd) \$25.00 (we) per person

Participants will build their own 'A' frame raft and paddle it down the magnificent Murray River. Recommended for summer/autumn months when the river is lower. All safety gear and equipment is provided together with qualified and experienced instructors to escort your group down stream. A great activity to develop team skills *(Bus Required)*

CANOEING

Duration: 2-2.5 hours
Cost: \$17.50 (wd) \$20.50 (we) per person

Participants will be shown safety and canoeing techniques before heading down the beautiful Murray River. All safety equipment is provided together with qualified and experienced instructors and a tonne of fun. *(Bus Required)*

Bus Required: When an activity states *(Bus Required)* participants can either use their own bus or hire one from Fairbridge at \$75.00 (half day) or \$150 (full day)

FLAT WATER RAFTING

Duration: Half day
Cost: \$33.00 (wd) \$36.00 (we) person

Participants are introduced to basic rafting techniques and safety practices before paddling downstream. Recommended for winter months. Also suitable for disabled people. *(Bus Required)*

OFFROAD/MOUNTAIN BIKING

Duration: 3 hours
Cost: \$27.50 (wd) \$30.50 (we) per person

Test out the exciting bush trails in and around Fairbridge and the local Darling Ranges. *(Bus Required)*

FISHING

Duration: 2-3 hours
Cost: \$22.00 (wd) \$25.00(we) per person

Conducted on the Murray River or a local Mandurah beach with easy to use hand lines. *(Bus Required)*

SNORKELING

Duration: 3 hours
Cost: \$27.50 (wd) \$30.50 (we) per person

Participants are taken out to explore the local marine life. Snorkels, masks and fins are provided. *(Bus Required)*

SURFING

Duration: 3 hours
Cost: \$33 (wd) \$36 (we) per person

Surfing lessons can be catered for beginners through to advanced levels by experienced and enthusiastic coaches, who are accredited by Surfing Australia. *(Bus Required)*

NIGHT ACTIVITIES

CAMPFIRE ACTIVITIES

Duration: 1 hour
Cost: \$90 per hour (wd) \$100 per hour (we)
or \$40 per hour (self-facilitated)

Night time activities around a camp fire to end a hard day of activities. Toast marshmallows, perform skits and sing-a-long. Only available March to November due to fire restrictions.

NIGHT TEAM GAMES

Duration: 1-1.5 hours
Cost: \$11.00 (wd) \$12.00 (we) per person

Have the whole group facing challenges together as team to try and beat each other teams. Can include Lantern Stalk.

NIGHT QUIZ

Duration: 1 hour
Cost: \$11.00 (wd) \$12.00 (we) per person
or \$6.00 (self-facilitated)

A great activity for all ages that really gets the brain working. Quiz questions can be tailored towards group needs.

CEMETERY NIGHT HIKE

Duration: 2 hours
Cost: \$6.50 (wd) \$9.50 (we) per person

Enjoy a night hike to Fairbridge's historical cemetery. A fantastic way to view the night sky and the openness of the bush and immerse yourself in the history of Fairbridge.
