APPLY ABSEILING SKILLS (ARTIFICIAL)




Units covered

SISOABA302A Apply single pitch abseiling skills on artificial surfaces

SISOABN202A Safeguard an abseiler using a single rope belay system

The best way to start as a novice is on this 2-day course. Personal skills, equipment understanding, knot requirements, belaying and safety are covered. Unit assessments can take place if you feel you already have these skills – through confirmation only.

	<p>GUIDE ABSEILING SKILLS (ARTIFICIAL)</p> <p>Units covered</p> <p>SISOABA303A Establish ropes for abseiling on artificial surfaces</p> <p>SISOABA304A Guide abseiling on single pitch artificial surfaces</p> <p>During this course, a foundation of rigging skills will be shown and practiced. From rigging multiple abseils to belay rigging and choices, this course will show it all. Guiding group requirements will be discussed and practiced. Group assessment will need to be arranged. It is recommended that Apply Abseiling Skills is completed before attending this course.</p>
	<p>VERTICAL RESCUE</p> <p>Units covered</p> <p>SISOVTR301A Perform Vertical Rescues</p> <p>This unit covers the skills and knowledge required to use single rope techniques and mechanical advantage systems to perform self-rescues and the rescues of others. Vital skills that cover both artificial and natural surfaces along with different exercises on towers, walls and high ropes. We recommend PD annually on this unit. Assessment can take place with confirmation only.</p>
	<p>BEGINNERS CLIMBING SKILLS</p> <p>Units covered</p> <p>SISOCLA302A Apply top rope climbing skills on artificial surfaces</p> <p>SISOCLA303A Establish belays for climbing on artificial surfaces</p> <p>Covering all the required personal skills, equipment understanding, knot requirements, belaying and safety, along with climbing features and techniques. Unit assessments can take place if you feel you already have these skills – through confirmation only.</p>
