2019 Fairbridge Leadership, Engagement and Development (LED) Project

The Fairbridge LED project is a unique training course aimed at giving participants a 'try-a-trade' style training program over 24 weeks. Participants commence with a Certificate I in Leadership (52773WA) with additional units from various other nationally accredited certifications, so students can explore a range of trades to establish what suits their skill set before continuing into Certificate II.

This unique style of learning will be complemented with literacy and numeracy support, mentoring, counselling, transport and food.

To be eligible for the **FREE** Fairbridge LED project youth must be aged between 17 – 24 years, not currently engaged in work or study, and *receiving income support from Centrelink.

**Participants who are not receiving income support may also be considered depending on individual circumstances.*
