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Acrophobia – Learn roping skills and participate in rock climbing and abseiling. Learn how to safely use the required equipment to achieve great heights!

Shipwreck Challenge – Groups work together to complete various water themed tasks earning golden doubloons. They then discuss how best to spend their earning on raft building resources to construct a raft and retrieve the treasure.

Snorkel Fantastic – Explore the unique coastline of Pt Peron. Develop the skills and knowledge required to snorkel safely as a group whilst discovering the variety of flora and fauna that call it home.

Discovery Paddle - A combination of skill sessions and instructional games on either canoes or kayaks, followed by a paddle up the river or along the coast

Water Balance Experience – A combination of fun games and skill sessions on the beach. Participants will gain water confidence, paddling and balance skills using landing pads, kayaks and stand up paddleboards.

Keep on Target – Learn safe bow and arrow handling procedures, and how to hit targets in a controlled environment. Participants also learn orienteering skill, using a compass to navigate the site and find targets.

Above and Below – Explore the remarkable shoreline above water on SUP's (Stand up paddleboards), testing your core skills and balance! Then grab your snorkel and fins and discover the shoreline from below. Learn about the marine environment and fascinating history of the rocky outcrops at Pt Peron.

The Point Peron Challenge – An amazing race activity where participants work in teams to navigate around the camp school, completing challenges to earn credits and continue. Credits are then used to purchase materials to complete the final challenge.

TEAM – Together Everyone Achieves More. Complete a series of team challenges to develop problem solving, leadership and communication skills. Then implement these new skills by completing a final challenge.
