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Canoeing – At Big Brook Dam or the Pemberton Swimming Pool (next door to Pemberton Camp). A combination of skill sessions and instructional games.

Shipwreck Challenge – At Big Brook Dam or the Pemberton Swimming Pool, groups work together to complete various water themed tasks earning golden doubloons. They then discuss how best to spend their earning on raft building resources to construct a raft and retrieve the treasure.

Bushwalking – The southern forests are an international bushwalking destination, and its easy to see why. Whether you wish to take your group for a short scenic walk out of the Pemberton Camp or a multiday expedition we can support and facilitate your experience. Bushwalks can be facilitated as leadership activities or with an environmental interpretation focus.

Keep on Target – Located at Bridgetown, learn safe bow and arrow handling procedures, and how to hit targets in a controlled environment. Participants also learn orienteering skill, using a compass to navigate the site and find targets.

Day @ Big Brook Dam – Participants travel to Big Brook Dam for a day of mountain biking, rafting, canoeing, bush walking and team games. Programs can be custom designed to suit the ages and ability of the group.

Yeagarup Adventure – The Yeagarup Dunes are the largest land-locked mobile dune system in the southern hemisphere. Participants will hike in from Lake Yeagarup followed by a support vehicle. They will run down the Dunes playing games and learning about the environment, followed by a swim in the lake

Pemberton/Bridgetown Challenge – An amazing race activity where participants work in teams to navigate around the camp school, completing challenges to earn credits and continue. Credits are then used to purchase materials to complete the final challenge.

TEAM – Together Everyone Achieves More. Complete a series of team challenges to develop problem solving, leadership and communication skills. Then implement these new skills by completing a final challenge.
